Q: How will we know that we have successfully signed the register?

- There is a note indicating that your response was captured that will appear on your screen. Please indicate if you have entered your details and have not seen such a response after submitting your details.
- Q: Does the contract manager have to be registered with a professional body?
  - Yes, for both Panel A and B, Only a Contract Manager with qualifications of Bachelors' Degree or Bachelor of Technology (Civil Engineering) or higher AND ECSA Professional Registration (Pr. Eng. / Pr. Technologist) or SACPCMP Professional Registration (PrCPM / PrCM) will obtain a score for experience of a Contract Manager. However, the date of registration of Contract Manager will not impact post qualification number of projects.

Q: Is 30% subcontracting applicable to certain contract values or all?

 30% subcontracting is applicable to all work packages that will be allocated under this contract in line with Clause 11.13 of the contract.

Q: MBD 6.1 requires us to list the subcontractors we will use. How can we do that without knowing the scope?

 In the case you have subcontractor you intend to work with, you may include those. The SMMEs that will be procured form the community are still unknown and thus cannot be listed. Contractors may answer that field with To Be Determined.

Q: If interested in both Panel A and Panel B, do we still need to submit resources for Panel A?

You can offer for both A and B. However, if you are pointed in panel, you're automatically appointed in panel B. If you are submitting for both, like Gcina said, make sure that the tender document is intact and not tampered with. You can give two separate submissions for panel A and panel B, but all of them should be submitted in one envelope.

Q: On the attendance register, I entered my details but the details that will be entered on the tender document will be that of the signatory. Will that be an issue?

 No, that will not be an issue. Just ensure that the company name is the same.

Q: Our COIDA is expiring at the end of the month and the SACPCMP registration is expiring on 31 March. Can we use the expired COIDA and SACPCMP registration?

COIDA is not required at this stage. It will be required later
after you have been appointed in the panel. SACPCMP
registration has to be valid. To claim points, include No,
that will not be an issue. Just ensure that the company
name is the same.

Q: Do all parties of a joint venture have to be in attendance of this meeting?

 No, only one party has to be in attendance. However, attendance by all parties would be helpful for awareness and improved knowledge

Q: The scope is not out at this stage, how must the tenderers complete the method statement?

The requirement is generic and is aimed at understanding the tenderer's methodology. The tenderers are required to provide proof with regards to criteria 1 and can therefore

	use those projects to complete the method statement.
