1. PURPOSE OF THE REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

To assist the organisation with business decision making purposes for an upcoming 6-months Request for Tender with regards to budget, cost effectiveness, risk assessment, specific goals to include in the tender, award and allocation strategy to incorporate, firm prices, pricing schedule and special conditions of tender. This RFI does not constitute; an offer; or any impression none so ever to do business with Johannesburg Water.

2. BACKGROUND

The purpose of the programme is to provide comprehensive skills development training programme for the targeted learners to gain basic technical skills in plumbing. The skills will enable them to earn a living in a sustainable manner and possibly enter the mainstream, through establishment of enterprises. The learner will be able to operate as a Plumbing Hand.

3. SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATIONS

As part of its contribution to socio economic development, Johannesburg Water seeks to support previously disadvantaged groups (i.e. youth, females and people with disabilities) in marginalised areas, within the City of Johannesburg. The company intends to invest time and capital in helping designated groups as this will assist in the unemployment alleviation and assist capable individuals to empower themselves in a sustainable manner. The aim programme is to address unemployment, gender equality and other poverty related issues in economically depressed communities within the City of Johannesburg.

The intended incumbents of the programme will be based within the identified areas in the City of Johannesburg (i.e. Alexandra, Diepsloot, Eldorado Park, Johannesburg CBD, Ivory Park, Orange Farm and Soweto).

4. CONTRACT DESCRIPTION:

The training service provider is expected to implement the following:

- Provide accredited basic skills programme in plumbing aligned to QCTO unit standards and certification requirements to 80 learners.
- Orientate the learners on the programme overview, the NQF level, course overview and expectations.
- The training offered should cover the knowledge component, practical component, and workplace experience.
- Register the programme and learners with the relevant SETA and QCTO.
- Presentation of certification to learners as issued by SETA and QCTO.
- Identify possible suitable venues within the areas or in the vicinity to areas targeted for selection by JW. (PS: venues should be accessible by public transport)
- Facilitate the payment of stipends to learners (i.e. weekly basis) including stipend administration.
- Maintain and submit learner attendance record for the reimbursement of stipend as administered above.
- Management of the learner database, including time management





- Submission of monthly reports and ad-hoc reports as needed on the progress of implementation of programme,
- Mentor learners throughout the implementation of the programme.
- Identify practical training sites for learners and facilitate the practical training for learners as part of the basic skills programme in plumbing.

Johannesburg Water is expected to implement the following:

- Appoint a suitably qualified training service provider duly accredited with the relevant SETA to offer the plumbing skills programme.
- Recruit learners to participate in the programme.
- Induction and introduction including handover of learners to appointed service providers.
- Facilitate the provision of approved Johannesburg Water personal protection equipment (PPE) to learners for use during the practical implementation stages of the programme.
- Provide a basic plumbing toolbox to learners as part of the implementation of the programme.
- Administer and facilitate timeous payment for service rendered by training provider, which includes:
 - Skill programme per month based on number of learners at inception stage.
 - Venue costs for up to three (3) for the service provider to administer theoretical (classroom) training.
 - Reimbursement of stipend(s) per learner including administrative costs, thereof, for the duration of the programme.
 - Basic plumbing toolbox for learners enrolled into the programme.
- Monitor the performance of the training service provider during the implementation of the programme.

5. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The venue (s) to be identified by the training service providers should be located in a vicinity where there is easy access to public transport, considering the departure point (s) of the various learners.

The stipend to be payable to learners will be based on gazette EPWP rates.

6. SPECIFICATIONS OF PRODUCT OR EQUIPMENT

The basic toolbox for plumbing should contain a minimum of the the following items, considering that these will be used by an entry level plumber with minimal experience in plumbing:

- 1. Wrenches adjustable, pipe and faucet
- 2. Pliers
- 3. Plungers
- 4. Hacksaw
- 5. Copper tube cutter
- 6. Plastic pipe cutters
- 7. Spirit Level





- 8. Tape Measure
- 9. Thread Seal Tape
- 10. Stanley Knife
- 11. Hammer
- 12. Blow torch.
- 13. Head torch.
- 14. Soldiering wire

7. DURATION OF THE CONTRACT

The programme will be implemented over a period not exceeding six (6) months, broken down into classroom and technical training.

8. WORKING HOURS

The working hours will be as follows:

Normal Time: Mondays to Fridays from 08h00 to 17h00

Overtime: No overtime and no attendance during weekends and public holidays
