1.2.2 GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS OF GAS DETECTORS

- a) The gas detector must have an adjustable alarm for each monitored gas.
- b) The gas detector must have a panic or man down alarm.
- c) The gas detector must have an IP68 rating.
- d) The gas detector must have a 3m drop certification.
- e) The gas detector must be compliant with all national standards (SANS: 1515).
- f) A calibration certificate must be issued by, or as specified by the manufacturer of the equipment.
- g) The minimum battery life must be clearly specified and stated in the technical information and specification sheet at the end of this document. (Minimum battery life of 12 hours required).
- h) The anticipated lifespan of the gas detection equipment must be clearly specified and stated in the technical information and specification sheet at the

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end of this document.

- i) Training on the correct use of all gas detection equipment supplied must be provided and certified to each JW staff member trained.
